



CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS – POINT SYSTEM FOR 2007/2008

Preamble: In 2000, the Club introduced the Club Championship Competition, based essentially on the degree of participation in Club activities. Five categories were designated, namely, **Club Champion, Competition Champion, Teams Champion, New Member Champion** and **Social Champion** although at the end of the year, awards were only made in the first four categories. The award of Social Champion was replaced by the existing perpetual trophy for “Outstanding Achievement Award”.

Categories for 2007/2008:

- **New Member Champion:** based on attendance at any Club events by a member who has joined in the current membership year. Only those who accrue 50 or more points are eligible, with the winner determined from the average monthly scores obtained, and at the discretion of the president.
- **Teams Champion:** based on participation in any Club event as a couple when travelling in the same vehicle.
- **Outstanding Achievement Award:** selected by the president, in conjunction with the committee, and based on outstanding commitment to, and involvement with, the Club.

- **Motorsport (Competition) Champion (& other Motorsport awards):** based on level of success in designated motor sport events.

Note: *Participants, organisers, helpers and spectators of motor sport events receive attendance points which count toward the Club Champion, Teams Champion or New Member Champion categories.*
- **Club Champion:** based on participation in any Club events.

Note: *Any member has the right to declare him or herself ineligible for any Club award.*

The points system for Club Champion, Teams Champion and New Member Champion:

- **Attending any single-day club event:** 10 points
- **Attending any multi-day club event:** 10 points per day
- **Organising and running any single-day club event:** double attendance points
- **Organising and running any multi-day club event:** double attendance points
- **Assisting in organising and running any single-day club event:** 1.5 attendance points
- **Assisting in organising and running any multi-day club event:** 1.5 attendance points per day you assist
- **MX-TRA: Writing an article:** 10 points
- **Contributing photograph/s (to a single issue):** 5 points

Note: *To obtain points, the participant must ensure that his or her name is registered with the event organiser.*

Motorsport Championship awards and points system:

Notes:

- Committee members with specific roles do not receive points for carrying out tasks involving that role.
- Committee members do not receive points for reports published in MX-TRA.
